

English: How much? Cantonese: **Gay door cheen? Gay** - the opposite of straight **door** - that's right, door **cheen** - same sound as keen D) Answer with Body Language

English : Good Cantonese: **Ho**

Sounds a little expensive. **Waaaah!** (**Waaaah!** is one of Hong Kong's great exclamations. Use **Waaaah!** at will. An English equivalent is Holy Shxt!)
